BONDA PRIZE 2003

The John C. Bonda Prize for Advancement of Photovoltaics awarded by the European Photovoltaic Industry Association (EPIA) Brussels under the auspices of the European Commission

Call for Nominations

The Bonda Prize 2003 will be awarded on the occasion of the 3rd World Conference on Photovoltaic Energy Conversion (WCPEC-3) May 12-16, 2003, Osaka, Japan

The prize honors the memory of John Bonda, a pioneer of solar energy applications. It has been awarded twice, both times on the occasion of the European Photovoltaic Solar Energy Conference (EPSEC) - 2000 in Glasgow/UK, and 2001 in Munich/Germany.

In 2003, it has been decided to present the prize to an architect with an outstanding contribution to the integration of PV technology into buildings.

The EU, in recognition of the importance of the presentation in 2003 on this world stage, has decided to make a financial contribution to the prize.

Terms of Reference

The EPIA Board of Directors will accept nominations for the prize until the following deadline date:

15th February, 2003

Nominations can be submitted by the candidate direct or through any recognized professional association. The nomination should include a letter of maximum 200 words outlining the nominee's key achievements with respect to the architectural integration of PV systems into a building, e.g. roof or facade installations, internal energy supply systems, etc. A brief curriculum vitae should also be provided.

- **→** must be a qualified architect or/and a consultant
- **→** must have made a significant contribution the integration of PV technology in buildings as an architect

Applications must include:

- **→** letter and CV as mentioned above
- → full description of the project, including kW size of PV installations and their benefits for the building complex
- **→** photographic presentation of project (Dias, CDs, and etc.)
- → a signed declaration from the applicant stating his/her willingness to travel to Osaka conference WCPEC-3, 12-16 May, 2003 (Bonda Prize to be awarded on Friday 16th May)
